A retention report in accordance with paragraph A.4.5.1 of MIL-PRF-55110H, Amendment 1 shall be submitted to this Center by January 31 of each year or loss of qualification may result. The report shall be based on the reporting period above and shall include data from all products built under the current and previous qualification reference numbers, as applicable. The report must also include the group B raw data along with a completed Form 36W for each qualification reference number listed on QPL-55110. If the manufacturer has no certified production in the reporting period, the manufacturer must indicate this on the completed Form 36W. DLA Land and Maritime reserves the right to request evidence of the manufacturer's capability to produce QPL printed wiring boards as stipulated by paragraph A.4.5.3 of MIL-PRF-55110H, Amendment 1.

Manufacturers are required to inform DLA Land and Maritime-VQE within 3 business days if a failure occurs during group B testing, if production of these products is discontinued, or prior to issuance of a GIDEP Alert and/or Problem Advisory on product represented by this qualification. This qualification listing is valid through the expiration dates indicated by the last 6 digits of the qualification reference number (mmddy), provided that all requirements of the subject specification are met. A stop shipment/stop production is effective on the qualification expiration date unless approval is granted by DLA Land and Maritime-VQE to complete existing contracts.
